SUMMER 2010

There is a limited amount of money available for students who need to register for up to three (3) credits in a summer session lecture course <u>or</u> up to one (1) credit in an independent study course. Any zero (0) credit courses (e.g., language requirements) do not require Graduate School approval.

Graduate students maintain their status as full-time continuing students during the summer session. Therefore, students are <u>not</u> required to register for credit in the summer session in order to have access to University facilities and services, as long as they are enrolled for the spring term and plan to return in the fall. However, students who plan on graduating in August must be registered and enrolled, but should register for a zero credit course if credit is otherwise unnecessary. **Tuition will <u>not</u> be approved for PhD-seeking students whose sole intent is to obtain a Master's degree in August.**

Applicants must be full-time students who are eligible for Graduate School funding. The eligibility criteria are as follows:

- 1) Graduate GPA of 3.0 or higher
- 2) Approved dissertation proposal if enrolled for more than eight semesters
- 3) Graduate enrollment less than 16 semesters

Summer tuition not paid by the Graduate School:

- Audits
- Undergraduate, Business School, Law School, or ESTEEM courses
- Foreign language courses for credit
- Three-credit courses offered during the academic year
- Course for receiving Masters degree in August for PhD-seeking students

Registration will begin on March 17, 2010. University of Notre Dame continuing students must register for summer session courses using the University's web registration system.
